Important Information- Indian Myna Bird Trapping

1. Neighbouring property owners are to be advised of your proposed trapping program, particularly where domestic pets may be impacted by the traps location.
2. The trap is specifically for the trapping & control of Indian Myna birds and must not be used for any other purpose.
3. Any native bird species trapped accidentally must be released immediately.
4. Any domestic pets accidentally trapped must be released and returned to owners.
5. Birds must be treated humanely before disposal which means you must ensure the traps have **shade** from direct sun and **food & water** is always available.
6. Traps are not to be placed on Crown Land, Council Reserves or private lands without the permission of the owner.
7. Please consider advising Hastings Landcare Inc of how many birds you have caught for our records.
8. Trapped Indian Myna birds are at all times to be humanely handled and destroyed, their bodies being disposed of in an approved manner. Small numbers of dead birds can be disposed of in domestic waste but large numbers should be buried or disposed of through arrangements with Council.
