**GALLERY RAINFOREST
(lowlands and foothills)**

Habitat: moderate to low elevations where limited to perennial creeks and ephemeral creeks with high flood velocities in the freshwater reaches of catchments where soils are well drained soils (may include boulder, cobble or sandy streams). Compare to smaller tributaries and poorer drained streams which have Swamp Sclerophyll Forest.

Localities: (part or all of the following streams and probably many other un-named streams in the LGA):
